50 - 60%

In June 2014 there were 5600 district nurses- 60% fewer than 15 years previously

AIMS

To provide management outside of hospital where possible and safe to do so

- Maintain patients' autonomy
- Avoid risks of hospital admission e.g. deconditioning, worsening delirium
