






A day in the life of a Pharmacist




Pharmacists will review all patients within 24 hours of admission (NG5, NICE).




Pharmacists advocate prescribing patient medications to be given at the same time as they'd take them at home to maintain routine.




Pharmacy teams can counsel patients to explain what medications are for and how best to take them.




Pharmacists can advise different formulations or routes for medications to suit patient needs such as managing dysphagia or challenges with time management.
