

2 hour Response Services

Services are designed to reduce avoidable admissions



A two hour response is typically required when a person is at risk of admission (or readmission) to hospital due to a crisis and it is likely they will attend hospital within the following 0-24 hour period



Services have multidisciplinary teams working closely together to complete holistic health, social and functional assessments

Teams might include Care assistants, Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapists, Nurses, Paramedics, Advanced Clinical Practitioners and Doctors.

Research has shown services to be cost effective



Services can liaise closely with other community teams such as GP's, Hospice's, DN's, SLT and more....
